**ויברך דייד -67**

David stood up and declared that young King Shlomo would use the wealth from his battles, to build the Temple and spread the word that Hashem is the Creator and Ruler of the world.

**אתה הוא ה' לבוך -68**

Nechemia came from Shushan to help Ezra encouraging the Jews, despite great physical and economic opposition, to rid themselves of their non-Jewish wives; sincerely repent and rebuild the Bais Hamikdash. Nehemiah 9:6-11

**ישוד -69**

Hashem destroyed the Egyptians to eternally impress His greatness upon the whole world.

**ישתבח -70**

Imagine yourself walking up the 15 steps leading up to the Sanctuary, singing that the Creator is the driving force of the entire universe.

**יזר אוד -71**

This is the longest bracha in davening. The perfection of the rising and setting of the sun encourages us to start our lives over afresh as if we were just born.

**אהבה רבה -72**

Learning Torah and doing mitzvot with true faith and effort causes Hashem in His great love, to give one the ability to succeed.
